14	license to a person who is at least eighteen years of age and

16	(1) has completed a baccalaureate degree at		
17	an accredited institution of higher education and has		
18	received a passing score on a state-approved subject-area		
19	examination in the subject area of instruction for which the		
20	person is applying for a license; or		
21	(2) has completed a master's degree at an		
22	accredited institution of higher education, including		
23	completion of a minimum of twelve graduate credit hours in		
24	the subject area of instruction for which the person is

1 (3) has completed a doctoral or law degree 2 at an accredited institution of higher education; and 3 (4) has passed the New Mexico teacher 4 assessments examination, including for elementary licensure 5 beginning January 1, 2013, a rigorous assessment of the 6 candidate's knowledge of the science of teaching reading; and (5) within two years of beginning teaching, 7 8 completes a minimum of twelve semester hours of instruction 9 in teaching principles in a program approved by the 10 department; or (6) demonstrates to the department, in 11 conjunction with the school district or state agency, that 12 the person has met the department-approved competencies for 13 level one teachers that correspond to the grade level that 14 15 will be taught. 16 B. A person seeking an alternative level one special education license to teach students with disabilities 17 shall be at least eighteen years of age and meet the 18 educational and assessment requirements of Paragraphs (1) 19 20 through (4) of Subsection A of this section, as applicable. In addition, the person shall serve a fifteen-week 21 apprenticeship under a level two or three-A special education 22 teacher while taking related and interwoven coursework at a 23 post-secondary educational institution that is designed to 24 25 connect pedagogical theory with teaching practice, including:

1 (1) lesson planning; 2 (2) classroom and behavior management for 3 students with special needs; 4 (3) learning theory; 5 (4) foundations of special education; and 6 (5) culturally and linguistically relevant teaching techniques. 7 8 C. A degree or examination referred to in 9 Subsection A of this section shall correspond to the subject 10 area of instruction and the particular grade level that will enable the applicant to teach in a competent manner as 11 determined by the department. 12 An alternative level one or alternative level 13 D. one special education teacher shall participate in the same 14 15 mentorship, evaluation and other professional development requirements as other level one teachers. 16 E. A school district or state agency shall not 17 discriminate against a teacher on the basis that the teacher 18 holds an alternative level one license. 19 20 F.
